A fun, educational treasure hunt where you will collect “Clam Cards” with fun facts as you learn the heritage and ecology of Barnegat Bay. “Clam Cards” are available from Clam Friendly Merchants while you visit places of interest all around Barnegat Bay. Get the full set! Earn points to win awards, post your favorite clam picture at www.reclamthebay.org or just collect Clam Cards!

You can decide on the part of the trail that is of most interest to you!

Explore for a day, week or the entire year. Use your Explorer Log (to the right) to mail in and record the information found on a Fact Plaque at each location (Example: Fact #...16, Location...4, Bold word... Filter. You may also record your points online at www.reclamthebay.org.

Note:

Exploring is not always easy! Some addresses are general and the Fact Plaque may require some searching. **Not all cards are located at the clam.** You may need to find them in a nearby Clam Friendly Business. Have fun and EXPLORE! Please report problems! Some Fact Plaques may be missing. If you can't find a Fact Plaque, enter the name of the Location in the “Bold Word” space and enter “Missing” across the “Location #” & “Fact #” spaces.

There are 2 ways to Register:

1. Fill in the Explorer Log found on the map, fold it and use it as a self mailer (address is on the reverse side, be sure to affix proper postage) **-OR-**

Awards:

- **7 points:** “Clam Diggers Certificate” presented by ReClam The Bay.
- **30 points:** “Certificate of Summer Study” presented by Rutgers Cooperative Extension of Ocean County.
- **40 points:** you will receive the certificate and the special ‘Sam the Clam’ stickers.
- **100 points:** you will receive a beautiful pewter metal clam or oyster pin.
