



VISIT AND SAIL ON THE AJ MEERWALD - NJ'S TALL SHIP

MEERWALD ARRIVES JULY 23 AND DEPARTS JULY 28 - CENTER STREET AND THE BAY, BEACH HAVEN

PEOPLE ATTENDING THIS EVENT, HELD IN BEACH HAVEN, WILL LEARN THE HERITAGE OF BARNEGAT BAY AND THE SHELLFISH ECOLOGY THAT SUPPORTED THE ECONOMY. YOU WILL TALK TO THE MEN AND WOMEN WHO SAIL HER. YOU CAN JUST VISIT THE AJ MEERWALD OR PARTICIPATE IN A 4 HOUR ECO/HERITAGE EVENT.
